Instead, guide them in constructing their own meaning.</i></p> <p><b>Methods for guiding children ages three through six</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Demonstrate empathy and build trust</li> <li>• Accentuate the positive</li> <li>• Encourage responsibility</li> <li>• Teach actions and consequences</li> <li>• Set a good example so children can imitate positive behaviors</li> <li>• Use positive reinforcement</li> <li>• Be consistent</li> <li>• Give freedom to try new things</li> <li>• Set reasonable limits based on safety and learning to function in the real world</li> <li>• Communicate honestly with children when guiding them</li> <li>• Share responsibility by giving children opportunities to help</li> <li>• Explain feelings of children in a conflict situation</li> <li>• Explain to children that everyone has strong feelings</li> <li>• Teach children how to manage anger without aggression</li> <li>• Provide physical activity and creative outlets to help children vent strong feelings</li> <li>• Praise and encourage children's talents and abilities</li> <li>• Discipline children privately</li> <li>• Help children build their self-confidence</li> <li>• Avoid child abuse and neglect</li> <li>• Participate in education programs for parents</li> <li>• Parents who think they might abuse or neglect should seek assistance</li> </ul>
